Instead they were to do exactly as Christ had commanded, preaching the gospel He had declared and ministering in His name, no matter what the result. And what about Paul? Hear again GAL 1:10: 'For do I now persuade men, or God? Or do I seek to please men? For if I still pleased men, I would not be a servant of Christ.' Instead of seeking to be a people-pleaser, the true disciple, and thus the true worshipper, mirrors Christ's uncompromising zeal to please the Father."
