DEFINITIONS

A HELLENISTIC JEW: a Hellenistic Jew consisted of those who were scattered among the Gentiles, who spoke the Greek language, and who used the Greek translation of the Old Testament, called the Septuagint. These were called "Hellenists," from a word meaning "Greek" or "Greek-speaking." To "Hellenize" is to adopt Greek culture and ideas.
