Title: "Liberty and Bondage"
Scripture: GALATIANS 2:1-5

The Christian is not under the Law. We are under Grace. (ROMANS 6:14)



DEFINITIONS

LEGALISM: a term Christians use to describe a doctrinal position emphasizing a system of rules and regulations for achieving both salvation and spiritual growth. Legalists believe in and demand a strict literal adherence to rules and regulations.

ANTINOMIANISM: comes from two Greek words, "anti" meaning against and "nomos" meaning law. Antinomianism means "against the law." Antinomianism is the belief that there are no moral laws God expects Christians to obey. Antinomianism takes a biblical teaching to an unbiblical conclusion.
