- ✓ The Law is discipline in that it lets us know that we **F**_____ in our obedience to the laws of God. (GALATIANS 3:19)
- ✓ The Law is directional in that it **B**_____ us to Christ as the only solution to our disobedience.
- ✓ In the OT, the purpose of the Law was to bring about **C**_____ of one’s sins. And it’s the same today. It is still our schoolmaster.
