ALIENATE (v): to cause to be estranged; to make unfriendly, hostile, or indifferent especially where attachment formerly existed.

QUOTES

"Reconciliation always portrays God as the reconciler and sinners as the ones reconciled, since it was human sin that ruptured the relationship between God and man (ISAIAH 59:2). Thus, reconciliation is not something man does but what he receives; it is not what he accomplishes but what he embraces. Reconciliation does not happen when man decides to stop rejecting God but when God decides to stop rejecting man. It is a divine provision by which God's holy displeasure against alienated sinners is appeased, His hostility against them removed, and a harmonious relationship between Him and them established. Reconciliation occurs because God was graciously willing to design a way to have all the sins of those who are His removed from them "as far as the east is from the west" (PSALM 103:12), "cast all their sins into the depths of the sea" (MICAH 7:19), and "cast all their sins behind His back" (ISAIAH 38:17)."
