Growing in TRUTH

“What does the Bible say about music?”

Music is an inherent part of every society. The unearthly sounds of throat-singing in Mongolia and Siberia are as important to their cultures as Bach is to European cultures or drum-driven song and dance are to Native American cultures. Since music is such an important part of life, it should not be surprising that the Bible says much about it; in fact, the longest book in the Bible is its song book—PSALMS.

PSALMS accounts for over 7% of the Old Testament. In addition to the PSALMS are other song- and poetry-focused books such as Song of Solomon, Ecclesiastes, and others. In the New Testament, we have song lyrics recorded in REV 5, 7, and 15; the mention of Jesus and the disciples singing in MATT 26:30; and the example of the apostles’ singing in ACTS 16:25. Many people also consider Mary’s Magnificat in LUKE 1:46–55 and the angels’ announcement in LUKE 2:14 to be songs. The church is commanded to communicate with each other “... with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit. Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord” (EPH 5:19).
