Scripture: JOHN 4:3-29

1. A divine appointment is commonly defined as an incident or meeting that might initially seem to be **R**_____ but is soon recognized as having been **O**_____ by God. (JOHN 4:28-29)
2. In a divine appointment we are never promised **C**_____. We are given **O**_____ . (JOHN 4:7)
3. The conversation in a divine appointment will always go in a **G**_____ direction. (JOHN 4:16-26)
4. We must always be **P**_____ to share our faith with others. (1 PETER 3:15-16)

VOLITION (n): the power of choosing or determining; an act of making a choice or decision.
