Social Distancing ...

It is good to be back here at BGCC as a Body of Believers assembled together to worship God! It is important that we follow the restrictions set up by our governing officials. Please follow these simple restrictions and conditions:

- J Masks must now be worn in all indoor public gathering places. It is required that you wear a mask during this service unless you qualify as an exception. The five exceptions are: 1) When eating or drinking. 2) While exercising. 3) If you have trouble breathing or are unable to remove the mask without help. 4) If you have a health condition that prevents you from wearing a face covering. 5) Children under 10.
- J We will practice social distancing. Please stay a minimum of 6-feet away from others as much as possible. Do not congregate in the front of church, in the narthex, in the parking lot, or anywhere on church property. Let's all keep a safe distance from others.
- J Seating is limited to one family per pew.
- J You may only sit next to those you have been quarantined with since this pandemic began.
- J Sit on the extreme end of the pew and stagger this seating. For instance, a husband/wife sit on the extreme right side of pew #4. Anyone who sits in pews #3 or 5 will sit on the extreme left side of the pew.
- J Masks and hand sanitizer are available upon request.
- J No hugging, handshakes, or holy kisses.

SUPPRESS (v): to restrain from a usual course or action; to exclude from consciousness.

And to suppress the conscience is tantamount to searing it with a hot iron (1TIM 4:2), leaving it insensitive and thereby dangerously removing a vital defense against temptation (1COR 8:10)."

Prompt obedience sharpens the clarity of truth's familiar sound, causing our spiritual senses to go on high alert. The more we obey, the greater affirmation we have that we are honest and genuine. A highly trained, truth-sensitive conscience will give us no rest when we edge toward compromise. If, instead of resolutely fleeing sin, we suppress the truth through rationalization and compromise, the clearest resonation of right and wrong will become faint. Do this enough times and no bell of truth will ring at all!"
