Social Distancing ...

It is good to be back here at BGCC as a Body of Believers assembled together to worship God! It is important that we follow the restrictions set up by our governing officials. Please follow these simple restrictions and conditions:

- ] Masks must now be worn in all indoor public gathering places. It is required that you wear a mask during this service unless you qualify as an exception. The five exceptions are: 1) When eating or drinking. 2) While exercising. 3) If you have trouble breathing or are unable to remove the mask without help. 4) If you have a health condition that prevents you from wearing a face covering. 5) Children under 10.
- ] We will practice social distancing. Please stay a minimum of 6-feet away from others as much as possible. Do not congregate in the front of church, in the narthex, in the parking lot, or anywhere on church property. Let's all keep a safe distance from others.
- ] Seating is limited to one family per pew.
- ] You may only sit next to those you have been quarantined with since this pandemic began.
- ] Sit on the extreme end of the pew and stagger this seating. For instance, a husband/wife sit on the extreme right side of pew #4. Anyone who sits in pews #3 or 5 will sit on the extreme left side of the pew.
- ] Masks and hand sanitizer are available upon request.
- ] No hugging, handshakes, or holy kisses.

DEFINITIONS

**DEPRAVED (REPROBATE) (ADJ):** The Greek word translated "reprobate" in the New Testament is *adokimos*, which means literally "unapproved, that is, rejected; by implication, worthless (literally or morally)."

QUESTION

Can a Christian have a reprobate mind?

Someone who has sincerely accepted Jesus Christ by faith will not have this mindset because the old person with a reprobate mind has been recreated into a new creation: "The old has passed away; behold, the new has come" (2CORIN 5:17). Christians are basically "new" people. We live differently and speak differently. Our world is centered on our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, and how we can serve Him. Also, if we are truly in the faith, we will have the Holy Spirit to help us live a God-honoring life (JOHN 14:26). Those with reprobate minds do not have the Spirit and live only for themselves.
