Series: ARE WE IN END TIMES?

Title: “Fear or Father?”

Scripture: ROMANS 8:12-18

- J Paul makes it very clear in verses 12 and 13 that we either live according to the **F** _____ or according to the **S** _____. (ROM 8:12-13)
- J You’re either in slavery to **F** _____ or you follow the **F** _____. (ROM 8:15)
- J Because to worry means we are trusting our **O** _____ devices before we trust **G** _____ provisions. (LUKE 12:28)



Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Just as it is written, “For Your sake we are being put to death all day long; we were considered as sheep to be slaughtered.” But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

ROMANS 8:35-39 (NASB)

FEAR (n): an unpleasant often strong emotion caused by anticipation or awareness of danger : anxious concern.

“The sovereign King of the entire universe is our Father. He has not only created us, but He has also recreated us in Jesus Christ and has provided everything we need. Paul tells the timid Timothy, ‘For God has not given us a spirit of fear; but of power and of love and of a sound mind’ (2TIM 1:7). Unbelieving, sinful fear is contrary to what God has put in us at conversion (ROM 8:15). We overcome the grip of fear by knowing what God has done for us through His Son. We break fear’s grip by realizing God did not give this fear to us; rather, He has given us the spirit of power, love, and self-control.”
