Title: "The Anger of Man"

Scripture: JAMES 1:19-21

1. **R**_____ anger is when we react against sin and understand that **G**_____ has been offended. God and His Word have been violated. Not me. (MATT 21:12-13)
2. **P**_____ anger is when we react against the world and understand that **W**____ have been offended. I have been violated. Not God.
3. **U**_____ anger is when we react against the Word of God simply because we do not **U**_____ it or we **D**_____ with it. (JAMES 1:19-20)
